


"Schmeisig" rocks for the residents

50 pilgrims had come by bus from Skarzewy, 15 directly from Czestochowa, the community of Father Zielonka, the spiritual companion of the Communio in Christo in Poland and friend of the Skarszewy pilgrims", explained Teresa Swieca. There were also children among the pilgrims who were very happy about a stop at McDonalds.

The group of pilgrims also visited the sanctum in the Basilica of Gidle. A small stone statue of the Virgin Marand her child (around 1517, only 9 cm high) is revered as a healer of the sick and doctor of the body. "Our Lady of Jasna Gora is the doctor of our souls in the first place," explains Teresa Swieca.

According to the Prelate Zielonka the meeting started on 21 July with reception and dinner. On Saturday a Holy Mass was celebrated at the holy place and later the participants meditated on the charism of Mother Marie Therese. The pilgrimage also included a visit to the Chapel of Saint Padre Pio in Przeprosna Gorka and a way of the Cross outdoors.

A further pilgrimage is planned already for January 2024. The community from Mechernich is cordially welcomed. As the Prelate Zielonka points out, 65 participants have expressed their affiliation to the close friendship to the Ordo Communionis in Christo and their sympathy for anc solidarity with the Superior General Jaison Thazhathil. The witness I bore for him confirms his love for me and for all who recognized it. May the sufferings directly connected to this foundation be also proof of the fact that the imitation of Christ means mainly that we have to carry the cross out of love for God and the Church …

This is what I as a foundress have to say: Let us not block the emergence of a kind of love coming from God. To make this visible, a light was lit on 1 September."
